Concept Note

Background & Rationale

Multiple approach to education aims to develop adaptable and well-rounded individuals who are well-equipped with twenty first century skills and capacities in diverse fields such as the arts, humanities, languages, sciences, social sciences, technical & vocational fields and to foster an ethic of social engagement as well as fundamental soft skills such as communication skills, work and life skills, quantitative aptitude (numerical literacy), language, and IT proficiencies.
