About the department

Established in the year 1961, the department of Zoology started its journey with Prof. G. K. Manna (FNASc) as the first Head of the department. The department offers M.Sc. (following CBCS system) and Ph.D courses in Zoology. The Department received financial assistance from Govt. of India under its DST-FIST, DST-PURSE and UGC SAP DRS. Faculties in the department are engaged in various research projects, funded by national and international organizations. During the last five years 20 (approx.) research projects have been handled by the faculty members of the department. About 800

research papers in international journals and 200 in national journals of repute have been published by the department. The research area covered by the department is Aquaculture, Ecology, Cancer Biology, Toxicology, Biosystematics and Taxonomy, Molecular Endocrinology and Signaling Pathways, Nanotechnology, and Molecular Parasitology.
