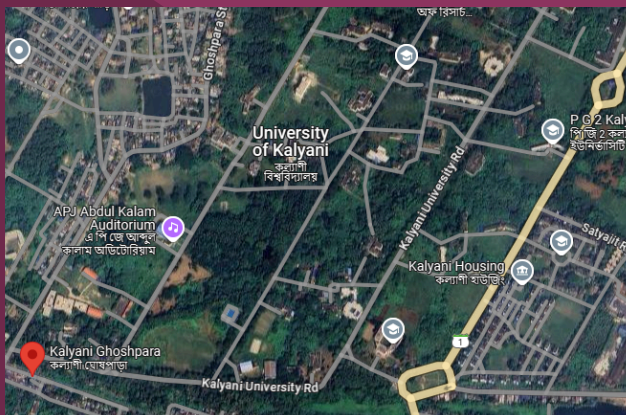


ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The Kalyani township established after the partition of India was the brainchild of Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy, the second Chief Minister of West Bengal. The area was used by the American Army during World War II. The Americans developed the area with well built parallel, perpendicular & diagonal concrete roads, characteristic of townships in USA. Dr. Roy intended to develop this partially developed township into a well planned city with industries, residential area & an educational institute of repute and christened it as Kalyani.

The University was established in 1960 with a beautiful and serene campus area of over 346 acres to cater to the students, researchers and the university fraternity.

The University is 53 km from Kolkata and can conveniently be accessed by rail or road. Local trains to Kalyani Ghoshpara are available frequently. The nearest airport is Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport, about 45 km away from the campus.
