## About the Department

Established in 1958 as a government-sponsored Teachers' Training College, the Department has a rich legacy of over four decades in the dissemination of knowledge. It expanded its academic and research programmes in 1970-71 with the introduction of MA/M.Sc courses in Education, followed by the initiation of research activities and the M.Phil programme, the first of its kind in Eastern India. The B.Ed. programme received permanent NCTE recognition in 1999, and in 2000 the Department was upgraded to an Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (IASE) by the Government of West Bengal and MHRD. Central grants supported significant infrastructure and ICT development. The Department introduced the NCTE-recognized M.Ed. programme and developed curricula for in-service teacher education. It has successfully organized national seminars, refresher courses, and workshops, produced NET/SET qualifiers, Ph.D. scholars, and contributed substantially to teacher and faculty recruitment, guided by its vision of academic excellence rooted in Indian tradition.

In many postgraduate (PG) departments, the dissertation constitutes a compulsory component of the PG curriculum. Further, in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 guidelines, research projects have also been introduced as an essential component of undergraduate (UG) programmes. These developments highlight the growing importance of research-based learning at different levels of higher education.

This workshop aims to provide a comprehensive understanding of the different components of a dissertation, supported by hands-on training. The workshop will focus on key aspects such as the selection of a suitable research problem; formulation of research objectives, research questions, and hypotheses; appropriate methodologies of data collection; techniques of data analysis; and effective writing of references and research reports.
