

About the Seminar

India's development experience in the new millennium has been marked by rapid economic growth, structural transformation, and increasing global integration. At the same time, the Indian economy continues to face persistent challenges such as unemployment, inflation, widening socio-economic inequalities, labour vulnerability, and environmental degradation. The processes of urbanisation, industrial expansion, and infrastructure-led development have intensified ecological stress through rising carbon emissions, deforestation, and depletion of natural resources, raising serious concerns about sustainability.

The Indian labour market has also undergone profound changes during the post-reform period. The growing dominance of informal employment, labour migration, technological disruption, and gender-based inequalities has increased workforce vulnerability. Weak enforcement of labour laws, inadequate social protection, workplace safety concerns, and exclusion from welfare mechanisms remain critical policy challenges.

In this context, the **National Seminar on "Contemporary Policy Issues in India's Development Experience"**, to be held at the **Department of Economics, University of Kalyani**, aims to provide a scholarly platform for critical and interdisciplinary engagement with issues related to sustainable development, environmental governance, labour challenges, and gender equity. The seminar seeks to encourage empirical research and policy-oriented discussions that can contribute to inclusive, equitable, and sustainable growth in India.

- Abstracts (300–400 words) must articulate the research problem, objectives, methodology, and major findings with clarity and precision.
- Full-length papers (5,000–8,000 words including references) must conform to established academic writing standards and strictly follow APA formatting and citation guidelines and to be submitted through the link <https://forms.gle/eMTpJeX8QQEy6kjk9>
- Submissions must be original and unpublished
